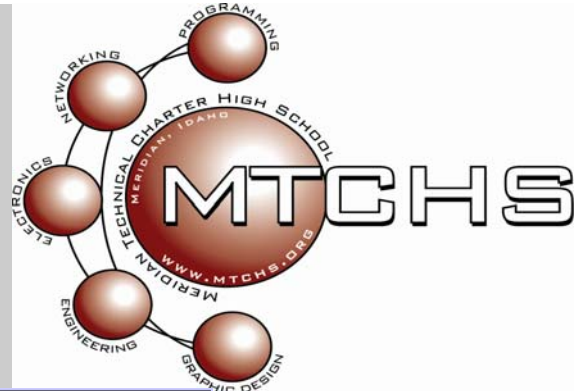

The MTCHS office will be closed for business from June 21—July 31. The front office will open again on August 1.

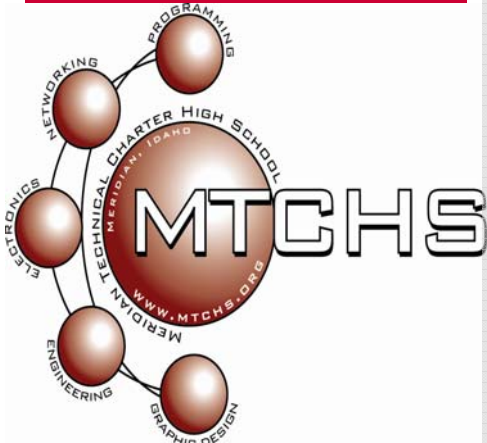
Student Leaving?
